3. **Entries close no later than Friday 18th May 2018** with the A&P secretary, PGG Wrightsons, Luisetti Seeds, Farmlands or Farm Source.
4. No late entries or phone entries.
5. Entry fees to accompany form or be paid into the Northern A&P Association bank account 02-0876-0024162-00 Please use reference Winter Feed.
6. District between Waimakariri and Kowhai Rivers, Poyntz Road and Rakahuri Road to the west, and including Coutts Island.
7. Judges decide if entry is correct and to transfer accordingly.
8. Restriction of two entries per class and a maximum of four entries per form.
9. Judge's decision is final.
10. BEST COMPLETED ENTRY FORM GETS A PRIZE.
